This funding will be used to

- Provide a whole school approach to in-depth data analysis, data monitoring and tracking across all year levels, with a focus on spelling
- To use individual and group data trends to inform teaching, learning and resourcing in spelling and phonics
- Ensure all year three and year five students reach national minimum standards (NMS) or more in spelling
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year level standards in spelling and intensive phonics
- Provide professional development in the teaching of synthetic phonics for all staff

Our initiatives include

- Developing a shared understanding of data literacy and support teachers to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching, particularly in spelling and phonics
- Building teacher capability and knowledge to ensure differentiation for all students to improve learning outcomes
- Monitoring and tracking progress of all students (including student folios) in Prep - 6 against Early Start, NAPLAN, numeracy continuum standards and school-based assessment
- Developing teacher capability to embed descriptive feedback within moderation schedule, teaching and learning cycle, targeting literacy outcomes
- Reviewing the whole school reading framework, which aligns with the pedagogical framework using a shared language of teaching and learning

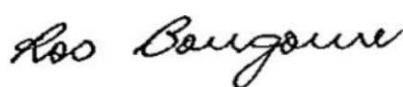

- Using Early Start, Numeracy and Literacy Continuum and school-based assessments to inform teaching, learning and resourcing and to track progress in spelling, vocabulary and phonics **(\$10 000)**
- Providing targeted professional learning in spelling and phonics to build capability for all staff **(\$9 000)**
- Using internal data sources (NAPLAN, Numeracy and Literacy Continuum, Early Start, A-E) to identify current achievement levels and provide targeted intervention and support **(\$2 773)**
